**TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS**

**Re: Integrated Survey Area (ISA) Official Plans and Coordinates**

New NAD83 (CSRS) consolidated coordinate listings have been issued for the following integrated survey areas and are now on record in the appropriate Land Title Offices and municipalities. The listing includes previous outstanding replacement projects that were awaiting the completion of the NAD83 (CSRS) refresh adjustment.

New official integrated survey area plans for Delta, Colwood and Langley City were filed in the appropriate Land Title Office. New plans for the remainder of the areas listed will be filed in the appropriate Land Title Office when completed.

Survey plans within integrated survey areas must be prepared using NAD83 (CSRS) derived grid bearings. There will be a grace period until December 31, 1998 for surveys which are largely already completed. We urge surveyors to use NAD83 (CSRS) on all plans prior to December 31, 1998 where possible.
