TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS

Re: Survey Restoration Fund

In accordance with the Surveyor General Branch's mandate to maintain and enhance the survey fabric of the province, a Survey Restoration Fund has been established.

The fund can provide limited financial compensation to land surveyors who discover and resolve cadastral errors or reset damaged monumentation that is beyond the scope of the survey for which they were contracted to perform.

In order to qualify to receive funding from the Survey Restoration Fund several criteria must be met including the following:

- Resolution of the cadastral errors or replacement of the damaged monuments must require work beyond the extent of that normally required for the survey for which the land surveyor was contracted;
- Resolution of the cadastral errors or replacement of the damaged monuments must be in the public or Crown interest; and
- The resolution or replacement must conclusively resolve the issue.
