CIRCULAR LETTER TO BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS

Re: Standardization Base - City of Vancouver.

This is to advise that the firm of Underhill and Underhill has established a series of P. Con monuments on the boulevard strip of 16th Avenue between Trutch and Trafalgar Streets in the City of Vancouver.

The monuments mark a three hundred-foot tape standardization base and as well, a series of longer legs of varying lengths designed for checking electronic distance-measuring instruments.

The distance 1 to 2 is a value determined solely by Underhill and Underhill with an MA 100 Tellurcmeter. The elevations of all monuments which are on the City of Vancouver Datum were also provided by the same firm.

All other distances have been checked in the field and confirmed by this Branch as shown below:-
