Over the years the duplicate tracing mentioned in the above noted section has been a machine-made diazo transparent linen print.

There are now on the market diazo films of excellent reproducing quality and I hereby approve the use of these for the duplicate transparency as called for under Section 80, subsection 11. Linen transparencies are still acceptable as before.

The film recommended shall be .003 inch thickness with one side a matte finish and the emulsion on the shiny side. This should be printed in reverse, so that the print will be read with the matte surface facing upward and be clearly legible.
