Re: Tape Standardization Base -
District of Coquitlam.


As a convenience to land surveyors working in the general area a tape standardization base has been set by the Department in the District of Coquitlam.

Marked with four aluminum bolts numbered 1 to 4 set on the roadside edge of the sidewalk, the base is located on the south side of the Dewdney Trunk Road 193 feet east of the centre line of Buoy Drive.

Distances between centre marks on the plugs are:-
