CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS

Dear Sirs,

re: Changes in Boundaries of Integrated Survey Areas

When any changes in the boundaries of Integrated Survey Areas are made, or when major additions are made to the control networks in the areas, all British Columbia Land Surveyors will be notified by circular letter. When small additions or amendments are made to co-ordinates by Supplementary Certificate under Section 5:02 of B.C. Reg. 577/74, these additions will not be circularized and it is up to the Land Surveyor to check at the appropriate Land Registry Office to see if any of these Supplementary Certificates have been filed.

The boundaries of Integrated Survey Area No. 4 (City of Kelowna) have been enlarged and additional monuments co-ordinated. The new plans and co-ordinates are on file at the Kamloops Land Registry Office. Henceforth, all new surveys within the expanded area must conform to B.C. Reg. 576/74.
