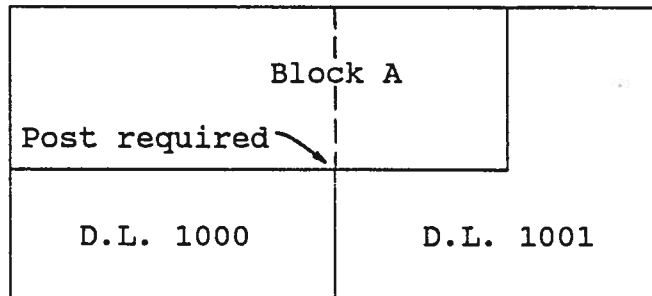
CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS

**Re: Surveys of Single Blocks over more  
than one District Lot or Section**

Single block designations are now being assigned to Land Act parcels which lie over more than one District Lot or Section or a combination of both. This practice has been initiated in order that only one legal description will cover an area being granted or leased as a single parcel.

When carrying out surveys of such blocks, the points where the boundaries of the block under survey intersect the existing surveyed boundaries of the parent parcels must be posted with posts of types 1, 2 or 4. This office will consider allowing posting without full retracement of existing boundaries where the conditions of Section 66(2) of the General Survey Instructions have been met.

For example:



The above would be described as Block A of District Lots 1000 and 1001, Cariboo District.

Please ensure that your surveys reflect this posting requirement.
